

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the CIMI stand for? And when is the list compiled?

CIMI stands for Catalina Island Marine Institute. The list is based on last year's 7th grade overall GPA. It is compiled at the beginning of the year and lists students from highest GPA's to lowest GPA's.

How do students make the CIMI list?

We invite the top 100 students with the highest GPA's from 7th grade. All classes are weighed the same. If there are fewer spots open than students with the same GPA, the student's names are drawn for the next spot. Some students that are invited decide not to go, another student with the next highest GPA would be invited or a name would be drawn if there was more than 1.

Why can't I see my child's current classes in Standards Score?

Be sure to check that you are in the current trimester. Trimester 2 is from 11/30-3/5.

How does my child get missing work when he/she is absent?

Either the day they return (short absences); homework request thru the office (long absences)

Should my child keep all of his work for the trimester?

Yes, keep the papers either at home or in a binder.

When I purchase something for my student, like PE clothes or an Action color shirt, who do I make the check out to?

Whenever something is purchased for a student at Ramona, all checks are made out to Ramona Middle School or just Ramona unless otherwise specified. This includes payments for field trips as well as fundraisers.

I bought something on-line where do I pick it up?

Depending on what items you purchase on-line will affect where you pick them up. Action shirts can be picked up in the Student Store. All PE clothes or locks must be picked up during the students PE class.

How are grades calculated for the mile in PE?

All miles run in a grading period are averaged against the students personal pretest. It then is compared to an established grading scale which is published in the PE handbook.

Are the kids out early today?

Compact days are only on the first and third Wednesday of the month. They are NOT every other week.

How long does practice last?

Practice generally lasts until 5pm.

In the case of academic issues, teachers can provide you with information regarding expectations or performance on any assignment. For behavior related issues, teachers can give you first hand information about the incident that led to parent contact or consequences. The majority of questions that arise from class situations can be handled with teacher contact. If after speaking to a teacher there are further concerns, a student's counselor is the next contact to be made for assistance.
