

Let's Stop Bullying!

This year we have two Interventions Counselors on campus, Doug Halvorsen and Cara Proffit. They both have over 30 years of educational experience. One of the ways they will support students is classroom presentations in all of the grade levels.

During October they will be presenting to all 6th graders in their Science classes. This month's theme will be on preventing bullying of others. They will be helping students to recognize signs that someone is being bullied or that they themselves are being bullied and how to get help. We want to make sure that students feel safe at school and answer questions that middle school kids have about the subject.

During November we will be bringing in an outside professional assembly to do a presentation on getting bullying recognized and stopped. The Esteem Group will be sharing an assembly with boys of all three grades on November 2nd and then again with girls from all three grades on November 4th. A parent night for November is being scheduled regarding this same topic and information will follow.
